

Vegetable Planting Calendar, Cool Temperate Zone

What to sow month by month in the cool temperate zone of Australia.

This zone covers Melbourne, Hobart, Geelong, Launceston and Ballarat.

Green means you can sow or plant that crop that month in this zone. For seed tray, transplant and direct sow month by month, and for what to do when the window is nearly shut, see the crop's own guide at gardenbuddy.au/veggie-guide/cool-temperate/.

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Perennials are not in the grid. Fruit trees, nut trees and the crops you plant once and keep have a planting window rather than a sowing month, which is a different thing and does not fit a twelve month row. In this zone that covers Apple, Avocado, Blueberry, Fig, Grapefruit, Jerusalem Artichoke, Leek, Lemon, Lemongrass, Lime, Macadamia, Mandarin, Mulberry, Orange, Passionfruit, Peach, Pear, Pecan, Persimmon, Plum, Pomegranate, Raspberry, Savory, Strawberry, Walnut. Each one has its window on its guide page.
